4. Why is the crucifixion so important to Christians?
5. Why do Muslims deny that Jesus died by crucifixion?
6. What are some of the evidences we have that Jesus was in fact crucified?
7. Why is the suggestion that Jesus did not die but only “swooned,” and later recovered seriously flawed?
8. Give a couple of answers to the questions “Why can’t God just forgive sins? Why was the atonement necessary?”
9. How would you defend the crucifixion/atonement from the charge of the new atheists that it is morally repellent?
10. What was the most helpful thing you learned in this lesson, or was perhaps particularly new or interesting to you?
