6. What are some things about the women involved that makes that part of the story particularly complex?
7. What are at least three things which the resurrection of Jesus establishes?
8. What does Paul mean when he speaks of Jesus' resurrection as the "first fruits"?
9. What was the most helpful thing you learned in this lesson, or was perhaps particularly new or interesting to you?
